

NUMBERS TRACE THE ACTION. IN ROUND ROCK'S MOST EXCITING TWENTY MINUTES

- 1. Elm Mott where Barnes remained with horses
- Saloon where Bass & Jackson stopped to buy a drink & where someone noticed that they were wearing pistols
- Kopperal's Store where Bass & Jackson were buying tobacco when Deputy Grimes approached and where Grimes was killed and Deputy Moore shot.
- 4. A small Drug Store to which Moore crawled for help
- Ranger Major Jones returning from Telegraph Office at IGN Ry Depot sighted Bass and fired upon him.
- Bass' pistol shot out of his hand by Blair standing in front of shop at 7
- 7. Blacksmith Shop
- Bass received fatal shot from rifle fired from back of Livery Stable. Jackson assisted Bass to trees where he & Barnes put him on a horse. Barnes killed there.
- Following the well used road Jackson aided wounded Bass to escape to some point on the Schnieder Ranch.
- 10. Small shack where Bass died
